Minutes of the March 2002 Rising Sun Four Wheel Drive Club Meeting March 6, 2002

Commander Rob Meredith called the meeting to order at 7:33 PM. Members and visitors introduced themselves and their rigs to the meeting. Visitors included Carlos from Florida and his 85 FJ60, Jeff from Colorado Springs and his 82 mini truck, and Robbie from New Mexico, who works as a mechanic part time at member Christo Slee's Land Cruiser shop.

Officer Reports:

Secretary Jeff Zepp read the minutes of the February 2002 meeting.

Treasurer Phil Simmons reported that the club has a current balance of \$2306.03 not including outstanding items. Dues are still owed by a number of members; so far 27 have paid.

There was no Vice Commander's Report.

There was no Land Use Coordinator's Report.

Event Coordinator Mike Aaron has drawn up an event schedule for the upcoming year. He reported that Carnage Canyon was Icy. The Cruise Moab pre-run is still on, despite overlapping with the Easter J**p Safari. Also coming up will be the Kremmling Rock Crawl.

There was no Webmaster's Report.

Commander Rob Meredith reported that we need volunteers to help with the Show and Shine for the upcoming Off Road Expo, which will be April 6-7. Len from the Colorado Association of 4WD Clubs suggested that Rising Sun could have a booth at the Kremmling Rock Crawl, and he envisioned a possible J**p vs. Toyota competition, separate from the main event. They could have 40 Toyotas and 40 J**ps, with 4 different classes and a minimum of 4 women drivers.

Old Business:

Rob Meredith reported that we have 100 entries for Cruise Moab out of 125 openings, but the registrations have been slowing down. Linda Bingham will be running the Registration Booth. James Bingham will be in charge of Vehicle Safety Inspections. Kim Brown and Darryl Brooks will run the Merchandise Sales. Chris Hatfield and Jeff Zepp will coordinate the Dinner and Raffle. Trail leaders were discussed.

Rob reported that in the wake of **Butch Lewis'** resignation, **James Bingham** had been nominated to fill his **Administrative Vice President** slot on the **TLCA Board of Directors**.

Rob had some questions from the CA4WDCI:

Q: What expectations do we have of the Association? A: Keep trails open.

Q: Have they failed to follow through? A: No answer from membership.

Q: What improvements can be made? A: No answer from membership.

Q: Do we have delegations to represent us regularly at their meetings? A: No, but Mike Aaron has volunteered to attend the 2nd quarter meeting as representative of Rising Sun.

Bill Van Beek delivered Rising Sun Cruise Moab tee shirts to Burt Toyota and Larry Miller Toyota for their parts staff.

Jeff Zepp made a motion to allow the Rising Sun bylaws and meeting minutes to be available for viewing by the general public on the club's web site. Kevin Ehrlick seconded the motion, and the motion was carried by a vote of the membership.

Mike Aaron made a motion to nominate Robbie as an Associate Member. Steve Crase seconded and Robbie was voted in. Rob Meredith nominated Brian Wilson for membership. Brian had filled out an application from the online form. He was voted an active member. (Secretary's note: the bylaws do not require a motion and a second for nomination for membership).

The raffle was held, and then the business part of the meeting was formally adjourned at 8:22 PM. Then **Matt Lewis** gave an excellent presentation on GPS basics.
